This is a seasonal full-time position with the possibility of permanent employment. Season dates begin April and end in July (approximate dates). The Biological/Restoration Specialist will perform infield data collection, analysis of restoration projects, and restoration research under supervision of CSR biologists and GIS analysts. Data collection will involve mapping utilizing GIS/GPS technology, vegetation monitoring, and monitoring of other flora/fauna as projects necessitate. Analysis will include data entry, data analysis (statistics), and technical writing. Other duties may include wildland seed collection, GIS database maintenance, or literature reviews. During the summer field season the position will require extensive travel with roughly 90% of the time based in field.
